

Safety updates

- Help Create a Safe Learning Environment
 - Exterior doors should not be propped open at any time
 - If you see a door propped open, close it immediately
 - All visitors/late arriving students MUST enter the building through the main entrance (Door 1)
 - DO NOT OPEN A DOOR TO LET A VISITOR INTO THE BUILDING
 - Even if you know them!
 - Report anything that you see or hear that makes you feel unsafe
 - Tell a trusted adult
 - Submit a tip to Safe2Say
 - Report the issue as soon as possible to help ensure the safety of everyone!

Attendance Procedures

- State law and school board policy requires daily attendance except for illness or serious injury.
- "Working from Home" is not an option.
- Written excuse required within 3 days of returning to school.
 - Deliver to homeroom teacher or the attendance office
 - Email is acceptable Molly Clokey mclokey@cvsd.net
- If a written excuse is not provided, the absence will be marked as unexcused and considered illegal.
- Reasons such as sleeping in, missing the bus, transporting a relative or friend, etc. are not valid excuses and will be classified as unexcused.

Attendance Procedures

- Tardy notes must be provided when the student arrives to school.
 - No note = unexcused tardy
 - 2 unexcused tardies = formal warning letter
 - 3+ unexcused tardies = after school detention
- Truant = 3 days of unexcused absences from school.
 - 3-day Truancy Letter mailed to parents
 - Attendance Improvement Conference is held
- Habitually Truant = 6 days of unexcused absences from school.
 - Habitually Truancy Letter mailed to parents
 - Referral to the Focus on Attendance program -OR-
 - Magistrate Court Referral


